TIMING

The contest begins February 10, 2008 and ends April 30, 2008. Applications submitted thereafter will not be accepted. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

OBLIGATION

Scholarship recipients will be required to give Digital Edge a release allowing the use of their names on our website and marketing materials. Digital Edge reserves the right to showcase the awarded recipient's profile and feedback.

The scholarship recipients are required to submit a letter of acceptance of the award and proof of college/technical school acceptance prior to the disbursement of the award. The college or university must be accredited and located in the United States. The winner must enter college or a university as a full-time student in the fall term following selection.
